

DOCUMENTS NEEDED FOR DUTY FREE IMPORT AND EXPORT OF HOUSEHOLD EFFECTS

Status	Non-Diplomat	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Custom duty, taxes and VAT must be pay according pro-forma invoice; - Copy of passport; - Visa and work permit ; - Valued inventory list of HHE (on Macedonian); - Residence and Import Permit from Ministry of Internal Affairs; - Pro-Forma Invoice (which determines the amount of customs duties and VAT); - Contract for Residence rent. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Valued Inventory list; - Original set of import documents stamped by customs; - Original Notice of departure from Ministry of Internal Affairs; - All original bills from purchased goods.
	Diplomat	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Stamped protocol from the Ministry of Foreign Affairs; - Original valued inventory list (on Macedonian), stamped by Ministry of Foreign affairs; - Stamped protocol from the Ministry of Finance; - Pro-forma Invoice; - Copy of Passport or Diplomatic ID; 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - New Protocol from Ministry of Foreign Affairs; - Inventory list; - Pro-Forma Invoice; - Copy of Passport or Diplomatic ID.

Important: All documents have to be written in English on company letterhead and should be signed and stamped.

NOTE: - Due to the constant political and economic changes in Eastern Europe, customs requirements are always subject to change..

IMPORT OF PERSONAL VEHICLES:

Diplomatic Status:

- * Protocol from Ministry of Foreign Affairs.
- * **Original** of car papers, i.e.: purchase bill, registration, certificate of ownership, license etc.
- * EUR 3 is obligatory to import and register the car.

Non diplomatic and returning citizen:

- * **Original** of car papers, i.e.: purchase bill, registration, certificate of ownership, license etc.
- * EUR 3 is obligatory to import and register the car.
- * Custom duty, VAT and taxes must be pay:
 - VAT 18%, Duty 8-10%, Special car tax, from 150 to 6.000 EURO (depend from cm3).
